Join some club or group of English language lovers, online or offline. Find an interest group so that you have something to talk about. If you are studying at school, university or other educational institution, try to speak English with your fellow students. Watch movies and TV series in English. If you don't understand everything that is said on the screen, you are still learning unnoticed by yourself. Watch the news and listen to the radio, subscribe to newspapers or magazines in English. Let English be the first language you hear in the morning!
